Comments from 6th grade teacher Kathy Johnson

- I have my students attend one class period a week from September to March working on 24 objectives chosen to meet their needs.
- I've found that the A-math program allows students to work at own pace, which allows me to remediate or challenge students as needed.
- I really like the instant feedback on achievement and overall progress that is available on the A-math program.
- The show-me buttons are excellent because it allows students to learn as they proceed through the program.
- All of my students spend at least one study-center period a week working on the assigned A-math lessons.
- A-math gives student the flexibility and availability of getting tutored in math even when a teacher is not available to help during or after school hours in the school library.
- I've found that peer tutoring from students who excel to students whom still need remediation is useful.
- Practice Test level 1 is great because of so many different kinds of questions are available that can be taken over and over until the students fully understands the concepts being tested.
- Plans are in the works to start the 5th graders on a-math and require them to complete the entire A-math program prior to enrolling in Algebra 1.
- The students love A-math. I have to schedule the students to the lab because to many would show up to work on A-math daily, and although we have a lot of computers we don't have enough to serve the demand for A-math.
